

# ***WOMEN WHO SWIM AGAINST THE CURRENT***

## **Lakselaget Foundation Opportunity Fund**

The Lakselaget Scholarship Fund was established to celebrate, encourage and advance the organization's motto, "***women who swim against the current.***" Its goal is to promote international connections between Norway and the United States, and to offer recipients an opportunity to learn, teach and share knowledge that will benefit women in their complex roles in today's society. This opportunity could be used to supplement funding for an international exchange or internship or a short-term international work opportunity.

### **TYPE OF FUND:**

The funds should augment the applicant's income during this short-term work opportunity or internship. When selecting recipients, matching funds from any of the companies involved will be taken into consideration.

### **AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP: Starting at \$1,000**

The scholarship check will be made payable jointly to the applicant and the recipient's agency or firm.

### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE:**

1. Women of any age;
2. American or Norwegian citizens;
3. Intended for Minnesotans who have secured a short-term work or work-related opportunity in Norway or for Norwegians who have secured a short-term work or work-related opportunity in Minnesota.
4. Workers in any field, and particularly those working biotechnology, mathematics, sciences and other professions where women are currently underrepresented are encouraged to apply;
5. Applicants must have at least one year of professional experience and be able to demonstrate competency in their field.

### **HOW TO APPLY:**

Download the application form from **[www.lakselaget.org](http://www.lakselaget.org)** under the 'Foundation' tab. Please assemble your application in the order listed below and include all of the items in one envelope or in one e-mail (if you choose this method, send your recommendation letters separately).

When submitting your application, please include:

- A. A copy of an official transcript from all colleges, universities or other professional training institutions attended.
  
- B. Two letters of recommendation. Please ask the individuals, who are writing your letters of recommendation, to sign the letter, place it in an envelope, close the envelope, and sign over the seal on the backside of the envelope.

Please include the recommendation letters with all of the other application materials when you mail in your application or send them separately via U.S. Mail or the Norwegian Postal System if you submit your application via e-mail to the Foundation Director. C. Up to a 1,000 word essay which clearly describes why working in Norway or the United States of America is important to you, how your employer will benefit from the experience, and/or how the international experience will promote opportunities for you. Include what you expect to contribute in the future, ideas for sharing knowledge internationally, and how your experience will uphold Lakselaget's motto, "Women who swim against the current".

D. A statement explaining how you meet the eligibility requirements described above.

**APPLICATION DEADLINE:**

To be eligible, your application must be postmarked by U.S. Mail or by the Norwegian Postal System or sent by e-mail and confirmed received no later than **March 1**.

**OBLIGATIONS AFTER FINISHING THE WORK STUDY:**

Lakselaget asks that you give a short oral presentation to its members at one of its monthly meetings, whichever month is most convenient for you. Lakselaget meets for luncheons on the first Saturday of the month from October through May.
