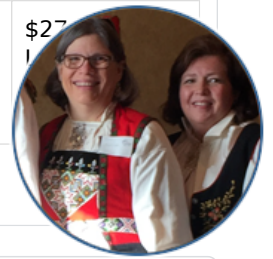
May Meeting Update (/index.php/meeting-schedule/may-meeting-update)
